🍁 Every year, people around the world host events to commemorate Terry's marathon. Get your class involved by participating in the National School Run Day on Thursday, September 30, 2010. You can do anything—hold a run, a walk or any other fundraising activity like a bake sale or dance-a-thon. Be creative!

🍁 Terry faced many challenges in his life, from dealing with his disease to running a gruelling marathon every day during his journey. Get your students to write a reflection paper on how they were able to overcome a difficult situation in their own lives.

🍁 Terry's determination, strength and generous spirit are some of the characteristics that make him a hero. Have your students create a collage representing what being a hero means to them using examples of their personal heroes and heroic traits.

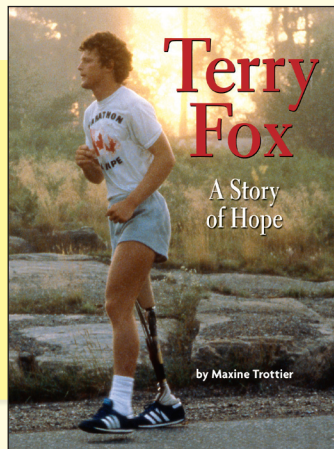
