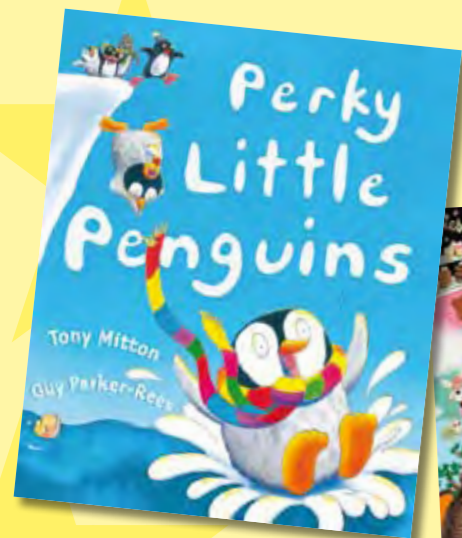




BOOK reviews
