The focus on inferring can be continued during Guided Reading. There are 32 Guided Reading texts to choose from, levels M–U.

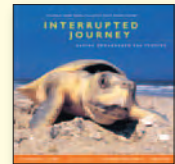
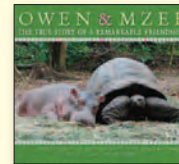
Sample Book Club Unit—Science

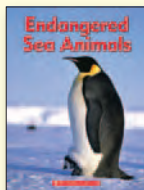
